

Dear Mr Trieman,

As a result of incidents in which you were involved in Wiv Hs last Tuesday afternoon, see attached note, the Vice Chancellor, acting under his disciplinary powers set out in Para 7 of section V of the statutes, excludes you from all parts of the University and its precincts within the Boundaries of Wiv Park from 6 p.m. today. 10 May 1968 until 10~~th~~ June 1968 (the date of the second ordinary meeting of the Senate, this term,) It is open to the Senate under para 28 of section 20 of the statutes to extend this period of exclusion, or to expell you permanently from the University.

I have written to the London borough of Enfield to tell them of this discision as well as to your adviser.

On receipt of this letter, you should return any books which you have on loan from the Library, and remove your belongings from your study bedroom. Your study bedroom key should be returned to Mr Butler, from 5.30 p.m. at the latest
