

I, Alistair Blunt, hereby state that I have taken Chairman's action, as the acting-Chairman of the Finance Committee, in accepting the proposals passed by the meetings of staff and students on Monday the 13th. May 1968 which stated;

① "That this meeting delegate power to take legal ~~advice~~ opinion with the view to instructing counsel in order that the excluded students be reinstated by the process of law.

That this depend on the result of any meeting with the Vice Chancellor which may take place today.

That this action (the above) is taken only after the proposals outlined by Paul Thompson be put into effect."

② and " That the University members present request the Students' Council to obtain counsel's opinion as to the legality of the exclusion of 3(three) members of the University for thier actions in protesting against chemical and biological warfare; and, if favourable and, if suitable, re-instatement does not follow, to take the case to court; and to avoid unnecessary delay, to seek an interim injunction if need be."

It is the duty of Students' Council to ratify this agreement at the earliest opportunity following the above date.
