Dear Colleague,

As you know from the Registrar's circular ~~our~~ official General Assembly is planned for 5.00 p.m. next Monday. In view of the developments at the mass meetings of over 1000 students and staff which were held yesterday, the staff members who requisitioned next Monday's Assembly feel that an informal and unofficial assembly could usefully be held today, Tuesday, at 2.30 p.m. in the Meeting Hall (4SA.4.1).

The V.C. feels he would rather await his speeches to Senate tomorrow and to the formal General Assembly on Monday; we have, however, consulted Dr. Sloman on this proposal.

Our feeling is that the membership of the General Assembly should meet today to exchange information and views both for their own sakes and to assist the V.C. and Senate to conduct their business tomorrow with the fullest understanding of staff opinion on the Dr. Inch incidents and the subsequent suspensions under Statute V (7).
