DETAILS OF THE MOTION PASSED BY AN OVERWHELMING MAJORITY
OF MEMBERS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ESSEX AT A MEETING ON
THURSDAY 16th MAY 1968

We propose that in the event of the Vice-Chancellor not being willing to exercise his statutory right to withdraw the suspension he has imposed on the three students, that Senate should take serious note of the feeling of an overwhelming majority of members of the University, and meet before noon tomorrow, 17th May, to rediscuss the matter in open court. And further that

- (i) the Free University continue until the three suspended students have been reinstated.
- (ii) all students refuse to sit and staff refuse to invigilate and mark examinations until at least one month after the reinstatement.
- (iii) the structure of Senate and other institutions be changed to make them democratic.
- (iv) until reinstatement the Free University occupy sections of the campus day and night.
