

The following motion was passed at a meeting of C.F.Y. Comparative Studies on Tuesday, 21st May, 1968.

The Common First Year Comparative Studies reject the directives of the Senate on all questions. Where C.F.Y. examinations are concerned we reject the present structure of examinations. We call for a multiform structure of assessment to be implemented this year which would include voluntary examinations for those who disagree with other forms of assessment. In addition, we suggest that this form of assessment be implemented in succeeding years.

Sixty-six members of C.F.Y. have signed this document within one hour of it being passed. If you agree with the beliefs stated, please come to add your name to the motion, which is kept in the Students Information Centre.

There will be a meeting of C.F.Y. Comparative Studies at 10a.m. on Wednesday, 22nd May in 4S.4.11. to discuss how we can implement our beliefs. These proposals will be discussed, amongst others, at the General Assembly tonight. Come and make the decisions that will shape your future.
