

A MESSAGE AND AN APPEAL TO ALL STUDENTS

PARIS 1968: The students and workers of Paris continue their struggle for democratic control..... Battles with vicious riot police (CRS) yield hundreds of student injured.....English students, including large groups from Essex University, are coming and going between Paris and Britain..... While there they are working in the hospitals and at the barricades.

FRENCH STUDENTS NEED YOUR SOLIDARITY
BUT THEY ALSO NEED YOUR HELP.

After the daily battles, the injured need help; every day there is more gas in the streets; money and food become scarcer in the refuge of the Sorbonne.

CAN YOU HELP WITH..

Medical Supplies- especially bandages, dressings etc.etc.

Money - for food; for petrol; for medical supplies bought there, and many other things.

Gas Masks - As the gas rises in the Paris streets, more and more people are suffering from its effects,; more so as tear gas is being replaced by the more sophisticated and more dangerous chlorine gases and CS.(World War types are not really suitable.The thin gauze type are better.)

CAN YOU GO TO PARIS YOURSELF..

Helpers are needed more desperately than sightseers.They should be ready to work a 19 or 20 hour, for Paris no longer sleeps.It helps if you know French, but it's not essential.
Hospitals have been set up by the students, in the face of neglect of injured students.People are desperately needed to work in the student hospitals, always crowded with new injured.

Cars, vans, even double decker buses, to act as ambulances. Please bring them, and bring plenty of petrol with you.The supply is declining in Paris!

Sympathy and solidarity are always very much appreciated. But it would help immeasurably if that could be translated into help and supplies. The address is the Sorbonne, Paris.
